The Hong Kong Adventist Hospital was established in 1971 and is well known for its' dedication to providing a premium health care service to the community, supported by state-of-the-art technology. This large, not-for-profit hospital, caters for all nationalities and cultures, and proudly boasts a fully professional specialist medical team, and multinational staff. Our hospital provides optimal and reliable medical services to the local residents, as well as to the Japanese and other international business groups.

The Hong Kong Adventist Hospital Theresa Po CyberKnife Center was opened in 2006, and is the first hospital in Hong Kong to use the CyberKnife G4 System, which allows pinpoint accuracy in the treatment of tumors that were previously considered too small to treat safely, or very difficult to reach. With the use of state-of-the-art technology, the AmMed Cancer Center at Hong Kong Adventist Hospital, which is affiliated with the well known and highly respected Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center in USA, offers a greater variety of treatment options to cancer sufferers.

The Hong Kong Adventist Heart Center was the first comprehensive heart center in a private hospital in Hong Kong. Since it was established in 1985, the Center has provided a one-stop service, of diagnosis, treatment, surgery and rehabilitation program.

In early 2008, we plan to commence Phase 1 of a new building project. This new hospital building will provide a very significant increase in inpatient beds, allowing us to cater for a much greater number of patients from Tsuen Wan and the surrounding areas.

We aim to not only educate, but also to assist patients and members of our community to establish a more healthy and beneficial lifestyle.
