[Hong Kong, December 19, 2016] The Hong Kong Adventist Hospital (HKAH) – Stubbs Road and Tsuen Wan proudly supports the Foodlink Foundation by joining the food donation program as the **first** among all hospitals in Hong Kong. Apart from caring for those in need, we also advocate the reduction of food wastage and sharing among the community through this meaningful program.

HKAH promotes total health and is the only hospital in Hong Kong that offers a vegetarian-only diet option. In our kitchen, food waste is minimized from the outset through the use of quality ingredients. Our aim is to take our plans to the next level by partnering with Foodlink in order to better manage and allocate left-over food. We also hope to promote healthy and nutritious vegetarian food and serve the community through donations. Mr Alex Lan, CEO and President of HKAH, says, “By joining the program, we are showing our dedication and commitment to our mission of health promotion and contributing to the society. We strongly advocate for more efficient and less wasteful use of resources, waste reduction and caring for the disadvantaged.”

HKAH will collect left-over food that is safe-to-eat and suitable for consumption in our two hospital kitchens in Stubbs Road and Tsuen Wan, and Foodlink will deliver the items to beneficiary organizations and needy families in the community.

Mr Wong Chi Wing, Director of the Food and Dietetics department of HKAH and registered dietitian, says, “We hope to promote the reduction of food waste and the kindness of sharing through our cooperation with Foodlink. At the same time, and we hope to raise awareness of the benefits of a healthy diet so that more people will make wise food choices.”
