前言

Adventist Health Hong Kong (AHHK) has been extending the healing ministry of Christ to the community for about 60 years, committed to delivering holistic health services to all segments of society. As a healthcare network with a global presence, its passion for health education, intervention, and follow-up sustains the well-being of the community. While the drive to incorporate Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) priorities in corporate responsibilities has recently grown, AHHK has always aligned profit with its purpose.

To continue promoting greater awareness and accountability of our commitment to the mission, AHHK is celebrating its community engagement contributions with our second ESG Report - Our Community's Health, A Continuous Journey. Reflecting upon our impact at both the micro and macro levels in 2025, the report highlights how lives continue to be transformed through our principles of creating belonging, building trust, and inspiring hope. We are also delighted to have received the Caring Organization Award by Hong Kong Council of Social Service in recognition for our impact-focused, collaborative community health coaching programs. This report also celebrates the continuous innovation in collaboration approaches with internal and external stakeholders, while promoting a spirit of voluntarism among our staff.

Without the heartfelt contribution of our staff and stakeholders, it would not have been possible to share so many inspiring stories with you all. AHHK aspires to continue the cadence of ESG reporting as a reminder to

港安醫療(港安)扎根香港超過六十載，一直恪守「延續基督的醫治大能」的使命，致力為社會各階層提供全人健康服務。作為擁有全球醫療網絡的機構，我們以健康教育、介入與跟進為本，持續守護社區安康。隨着環境、社會及管治(ESG)成為企業責任的重要一環，港安自始至終都利潤與使命並重。

AHHK — Our story

港安 — 我們的故事

AHHK has been rooted in Hong Kong for over half a century and is part of the global healthcare network of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, under whose umbrella the total number of hospitals and healthcare facilities exceeds 2,000. In Hong Kong, it operates two hospitals: Stubbs Road and Tsuen Wan, along with medical centers in Causeway Bay and Taikoo Place, providing nearly 600 beds and over 40 specialist services.

As the only medical institution in Hong Kong to receive Joint Commission International (JCI) accreditation three times and to be awarded the "Gold Seal of Approval" twice, AHHK is committed to stay at the forefront of medical technology. Its core specialties include the Heart Center and Robotic Surgery Center, equipped with advanced robotic surgical systems and hybrid catheterization and interventional operating room, offering 24-hour emergency services, outpatient clinics, and inpatient care.

AHHK promotes a holistic health philosophy, viewing individuals as complete entities. In addition to focusing on disease treatment, it actively advocates for preventive medicine and healthy lifestyles. AHHK has also established a charity fund to provide medical assistance and customized health plans for individuals, families, and businesses to comprehensively safeguard the health of the community.

港安扎根香港逾半世紀，隸屬基督復臨安息日會全球醫療網絡，旗下醫院及醫療機構總數超過2,000間。港安在本港設有司徒拔道及荃灣兩所醫院，以及銅鑼灣、太古坊兩所醫療中心，共提供近 600 張病床及逾 40 項專科服務。

作為全港唯一三度榮獲國際聯合委員會 (JCI) 認證並兩度獲頒「認證金章」的醫療機構，我們緊貼醫療發展趨勢，保持技術領先地位，設有多個優質專科中心，其中以心臟中心與機械臂外科中心為核心專科，配備多台機械臂手術系統及混合式心導管手術室等先進設備，提供 24 小時急診、專科門診與住院服務。

港安秉持「全人健康」理念，視人為完整個體，既重視疾病根治，亦積極推動預防醫學及健康生活方式。我們心繫弱勢，設立慈善基金提供醫療援助，傳遞健康與希望。同時為個人、家庭及企業定制健康方案，全面守護市民健康。

Building Stronger Communities through Purposeful Investments

AHHK advocates holistic and sustainable strategies to empower stakeholders and foster healthier communities. Beginning with families as the foundational unit and extending through workplaces to communities across Hong Kong, we are dedicated to creating lasting positive impact for our environment and stakeholders.

Transforming the health of at-risk families through CHAMP



透過CHAMP改善高危家庭的健康

Delivered in partnership with the Hong Kong Family Welfare Society (HKFWS) and with the support of Bayview Church of Seventh-Day Adventists and Hong Kong Adventist College, the CHAMP initiative (Community Health Assessment and Management Program) is dedicated to enhancing the wellbeing of at-risk families. Blending lifestyle management coaching sessions with practical steps aimed at tackling socio-economic habits and behaviours associated with poor health, CHAMP continued to expand its reach in 2025 – serving 75 families from Tuen Mun and Tseung Kwan O, benefiting 148 individuals with the support of 88 dedicated volunteers.

This year's efforts were particularly meaningful, as the programme extended care to a special, well-deserving group of foster parents in Tuen Mun who have long served the community selflessly. CHAMP's impactful commitment to sustainable community was also recognised externally this year, earning the hospital its first nomination-based Caring Organization award from the Hong Kong Council of Social Service (HKCSS).

由香港家庭福利會 (HKFWS) 主辦，並獲得灣景基督復臨安息日會及香港三育書院支持，CHAMP (社區健康評估及管理計劃) 致力提升高危家庭的整體健康水平。計劃結合生活管理輔導及實踐步驟，協助參加者改善受社會及經濟因素影響的不良生活習慣。2025年，CHAMP 的服務進一步擴展至屯門及將軍澳地區，共支援 75 個家庭、惠及 148 名人士，並有 88 位熱心義工共同參與。

特別值得一提的是，計劃今年為一群長期無私奉獻的屯門寄養父母提供健康支援，以向他們表達由衷的感謝與關懷。此外，港安亦首次獲香港社會服務聯會 (HKCSS) 提名，榮獲「商界展關懷」標誌，以表彰CHAMP 在推動可持續社區健康方面的努力與成果。

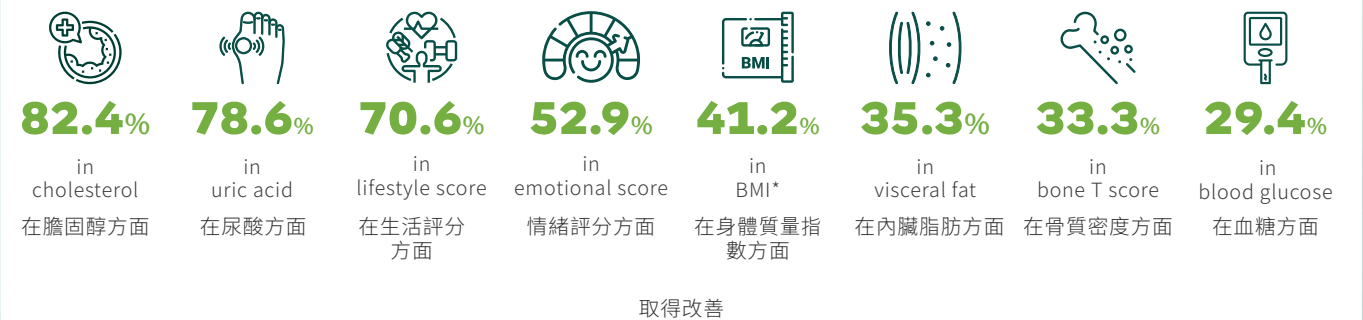

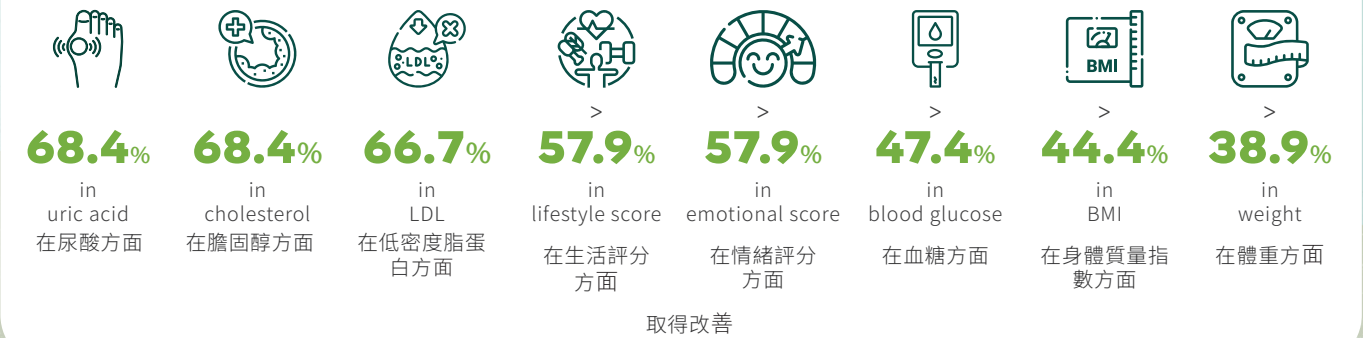

Empowering Tuen Mun foster parents through CHAMP's holistic care

全方位關懷—為屯門寄養家庭注入健康力量

Good health among foster parents is vital to ensure stability for the children they care for, preventing disruptions from frequent changes of caregivers. For Peter (pseudonym), a sedentary lifestyle had led to a persistent wide waistline and mobility problems. Through CHAMP, he was guided to take regular walks and adopt pain-relieving exercises, with caring volunteers offering constant encouragement to help him make steady lifestyle improvements. Their support even inspired him to give up his daily coffee habit.

Beyond physical health, CHAMP also touched on emotional wellbeing. Peter was deeply inspired by engaging health talks from speakers such as Professor Keith Lau of HKUST, who shared insights on the power of love and quality time in fostering a child's long-term mental health. Feeling renewed both in body and spirit, Peter now hopes more families can benefit from Adventist Hospital's holistic, lifestyle-based health programmes.

CHAMP 除了關注身體健康，亦著重心靈成長。彼得深受來自香港科技大學劉啟業教授的健康講座啟發，明白寄養父母以愛與陪伴灌溉孩子心靈，對其長遠精神健康的重要性。如今的他身心煥然一新，期盼更多家庭能透過港安醫院的全人健康計劃獲得裨益。

Building healthier families through CHAMP in Tseung Kwan O

May (pseudonym) was drawn to CHAMP in Tseung Kwan O because of its family-centred approach, which encourages loved ones to support each other in making lifestyle changes. As a carer, she had felt helpless when her mother was suddenly restricted from many of her favourite foods. With guidance from a dedicated team of volunteers, May and her mother were encouraged to explore enjoyable alternatives that supported better health without feeling deprived.

Beyond diet, CHAMP's physical activities helped strengthen family bonds. May was deeply moved to see her mother so engaged that she was reluctant to leave early. The programme also raised awareness on managing rising healthcare costs in an ageing society through lifestyle-based prevention. May now hopes more families can benefit from CHAMP's caring, professional, volunteer-driven health coaching.

除了飲食調整，CHAMP的體能活動更促進了家庭連繫。美玲感動地見證母親投入活動，樂在其中。計劃亦啟發家庭如何透過改變生活方式，應對人口老化帶來的醫療開支壓力。如今，她盼望更多家庭能從 CHAMP 專業義工團隊的關懷健康指導中受惠。

Empowering holistic workplace wellness through Ahealth@Work

As awareness grows around the importance of both physical and mental wellbeing in driving productivity and team engagement, more employers are taking proactive steps to build a healthier workforce. Through Ahealth@Work, AHHK designs dedicated wellness solutions aligned with the evolving needs of corporations, ranging from health talks and screenings to practical workshops on nutrition, exercise, and mental resilience as well as bespoke corporate wellness programs.

In 2025, Ahealth@Work delivered 108 health talks and screenings across 56 partner companies, including 30 newly engaged organizations. By drawing on AHHK's expertise and trusted reputation in healthcare, the programme helps businesses create supportive environments where employees can thrive, fostering long-term wellness that benefits both people and organizations alike.

隨着越來越多企業意識到員工身心健康對工作表現與團隊凝聚力的重要性，僱主們正積極推動更健康、更有支持性的工作文化。透過 Ahealth@Work，港安為企業度身設計健康管理方案，內容涵蓋健康講座及身體檢查、營養與運動實踐工作坊，以至心理健康培訓、專屬企業健康計劃，全面關顧員工的身心需要。

2025 年，Ahealth@Work 與 56 間企業合作（當中包括 30 間新夥伴），合共舉辦 108 場健康講座及檢查活動。憑藉港安豐富的專業經驗與信譽，該計劃協助企業建立更關懷、更具活力的職場文化，讓員工得以身心健康地發展，同時實現企業與員工的可持續成長。

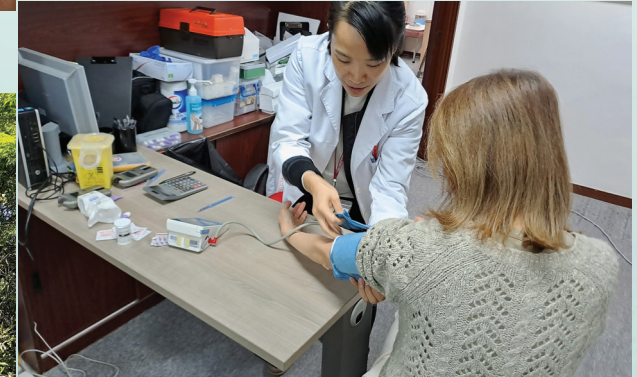

Promoting community health and wellness across Tsuen Wan

推動荃灣社區健康與福祉

AHHK continues to strengthen its connection with the Tsuen Wan community, promoting a culture of proactive health and wellness. In collaboration with the Home Affairs Department's Care Teams and various community partners, AHHK organised a series of health screening events across the district.

In 2025, 31 screenings were conducted, benefiting 2,393 participants—mainly from underprivileged, elderly, ethnic minority, and special-needs groups. Centred on the year's "healthy liver" theme, the initiative expanded access to liver screenings for early detection and timely care, while also offering bone density and blood glucose checks. Complementary wellness activities such as cooking classes and stress management programmes further fostered holistic community health and wellbeing.

港安一直積極加強與荃灣社區的連繫，推廣主動關顧身心的健康文化。港安與民政事務總署「關愛隊」及多個社區夥伴合作，在區內舉辦一系列健康檢查活動，將基層健康服務帶到居民身邊。

2025年共舉行31場社區健康檢查，服務2,393名參加者，主要為基層、長者、少數族裔及有特殊需要的人士。活動以年度主題「珍肝寶貝」為重點，透過肝臟檢查加強早期發現並及時轉介跟進脂肪肝問題，同時提供骨質密度及血糖檢測等服務。配合營養烹飪班及壓力管理等健康活動，計劃進一步推動社區在生活方式、身心靈等多方面邁向更全面的健康。

Serving vulnerable communities through our Outreach Care Programme

關愛計劃—關顧弱勢社群

AHHK continues to advance its Outreach Care Program, launched in 2020, to deliver comprehensive health services directly within local communities and support those most in need. Partnering closely with the Hong Kong-Macao Conference of the Seventh-Day Adventist Church, NGOs and charitable organisations, the initiative builds meaningful collaborations that extend care to vulnerable populations right where they live.

This year, we placed special emphasis on the holistic development of children and youth, while continuing to distribute care packages and conduct home visits for the elderly and low-income families. We also organized Fun Week for youth, responding to grassroots needs through concrete actions.

Health and wellness initiatives supported by Adventist Medical Centers

Adventist Medical Centers (AMC) in Causeway Bay and Taikoo Place offer comprehensive one-stop general and specialist care, outpatient surgeries, diagnostic screenings, and wellness assessments. Combining state-of-the-art technologies with professional services, AMC also actively supports community health initiatives. In 2025, AMC empowered approximately 2,455 children from low-income families on their wellness journey, supporting various areas including ophthalmology, electrocardiography, colorectal cancer screening, chronic disease screening, and vaccination cases. AMC also organizes free health seminars and sponsors the World Vision Hong Kong Charity Run.

Restoring elderly vision through Charity Cataract Program

讓長者重見光明—生活再現希望

Since 2020, the Charity Cataract Program launched by the Hong Kong Adventist Hospital Foundation – Board of Governors (Tsuen Wan) has restored eyesight for hundreds of elderly people facing financial hardship, giving them back dignity and hope. Among them is a couple affectionately known as Auntie Hua and her husband.

In their later years, both fell ill: her husband's stroke, cataract and cognitive impairment left him with severely limited mobility, while Auntie Hua suffered from years of headaches and dizziness with no clear diagnosis. As the days went by, they could only lean on each other and struggle through life together – until volunteers from the hospital stepped into their lives.

Through the program, her husband received free cataract surgery, allowing him to see clearly again and rekindling his hope. With funding support from the Foundation, Auntie Hua underwent a free MRI scan that finally revealed the root cause of her longstanding condition, enabling her to plan ahead in time. "This is not just help, but a warm embrace of care that has changed our lives," she says gratefully. Today, Auntie Hua actively participates in church and hospital activities, having rediscovered her smile and vitality.

Back on his feet – restoring a life in motion 重塑人生步伐—楊先生重拾 工作能力

For years, every step caused tremendous pain for Mr. Yeung. As a professional painter, his livelihood depended on his strength and mobility, but severe knee pain eventually made climbing ladders and standing for hours an impossible task. Forced to leave the craft he took pride in, the physical pain was compounded by the heavy burden of losing his independence. Everything changed when the Foundation (Stubbs Road) stepped in. As the first private hospital to launch the Robotic-Assisted Total Knee Replacement Surgery Charity Program, we provided the advanced technology and precision Mr. Yeung desperately needed for a rapid recovery. Today, the pain that once clouded his future has faded. Filled with newfound optimism, Mr. Yeung is ready to pick up his brushes once again—standing tall and returning to the work that defines his life.

Protecting Our Planet 守護地球

As a patient-centric and center of excellence care, AHHK is doing its part to care for the environment. To reduce our carbon footprint, combat climate change, and pursue sustainability goals, we have implemented comprehensive measures to tackle these challenges diligently.

Incremental gains for lasting environmental impact 循序漸進—成就永續未來

In 2025, we have renewed our resolved to drive down our carbon footprint by building on existing initiatives and innovation in the way to deal with wastes. Moving beyond prior efforts like LED lighting retrofits and lux sensors, we launched expanded recycling initiatives covering confidential documents and toner cartridges from wards, clinics and back offices, installing new three-colour bins at key locations like the 6/F sky garden and LG2 unloading area. Our laundry service transitioned to eco-friendly detergents certified low-VOC (volatile organic compounds), EDTA (ethylenediaminetetraacetic acid)-free, APEO (alkylphenol ethoxylates)-free and fully biodegradable per OECD 301 (Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development Test 301) standards. We also transformed the water feature into a green feature wall to reduce evaporation and leakage losses, introduced regular edible food donations to Foodlink foundation, and installed solar-powered bollard lights for the 6/F sky garden and G/F parking area.

Meanwhile, staff awareness grew through engaging events, including CLP Green Studio's immersive environmental film screening—which drew broad participation across departments—and Hong Kong Electric's practical decarbonisation seminar tailored for managers, sharing actionable strategies for medical sector emissions reduction. These coordinated initiatives not only advance our net zero journey but also enhance operational efficiency, reduce costs and without compromising our commitment to exceptional patient care.

於2025年，我們重申減少碳足跡的承諾，並在既有基礎上推動創新，提升廢物處理的整體成效。建基於過往更換LED燈及光感應器等措施，我們進一步擴大廢物回收工作，涵蓋病房、診所及後勤部門的機密文件及碳粉盒，並於六樓空中花園及LG2卸貨區增設三色回收箱。洗衣服務改用了低VOC（揮發性有機化合物）、無EDTA（乙二胺四乙酸）、無APEO（烷基酚聚氧乙烯醚）且符合OECD 301（經濟合作與發展組織）可完全生物降解標準的環保洗劑。我們亦將原有水景改建為綠化特色牆，以減少水分蒸發及滲漏；定期向膳心連基金捐贈食物；並計劃在六樓空中花園及地面停車場安裝太陽能燈柱。

與此同時，我們透過舉辦多元活動，以提升員工的環保意識，包括與中電合辦的「綠D班」沉浸式環保電影體驗，以及為管理人員舉辦由港燈主講的減碳實務講座，分享在醫療行業可行的減排策略。這些合作項目不僅推動零碳進程，更提升了營運效率，在降低成本的同時，亦堅守了我們為病人提供卓越護理服務的承諾。

Corporate governance fundamentally integrates sustainable development into major financial decisions. Pursuant to this, we partner with parties of aligned interest to further the cause to enhancing the social capital of Hong Kong. Pioneering a new frontier, Bank of Communications (Hong Kong) Limited has been engaged to serve as Mandated Lead Arranger and Bookrunner, Original Lender, Agent, Security Agent, and Social Loan Coordinator for the term loan facilities financing Hong Kong Adventist Hospital – Stubbs Road's redevelopment project. Structured as social loans, this transaction reflects market confidence in healthcare and our commitment to enhancing community access and quality of care. As our group's Hong Kong's first private hospital social loan, it establishes a market benchmark for similar initiatives for the industry.
