(Hong Kong — November 18, 2025) Hong Kong Adventist Hospital (HKAH) is pleased to announce the official confirmation of the establishment of Hong Kong's third medical school at The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST), and extends heartfelt congratulations. This significant milestone not only marks a major advancement in local medical education but also represents a proactive step forward in Hong Kong's healthcare sector.

As one of the 244 hospitals within the "Adventist Health" global network, HKAH is committed to providing high-quality, personalized medical services to patients while actively introducing advanced medical technologies. The hospital is honored to participate in this important developmental journey and contribute to the progress of healthcare in Hong Kong. A formal memorandum of understanding was signed on March 3 of this year, aiming to leverage this collaboration to promote further development in the medical field.

- Global Training and Research: HKAH is part of the global healthcare network of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, with hospitals, medical schools, and universities in the United States, Australia, Japan, Korea and Malaysia. - Centers of Excellence: In response to community needs, multiple specialized centers of excellence will be established to promote community health-oriented projects and practice patient-centered care.

Mr. Alex Lan, President and CEO of Hong Kong Adventist Hospital, expressed his congratulations to HKUST on the approval of establishing the third medical school. He stated, 'As Hong Kong faces an aging population, the demand for medical professionals has become imperative.
