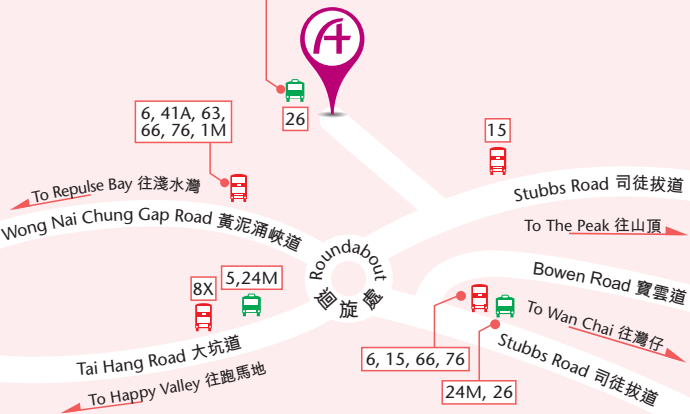
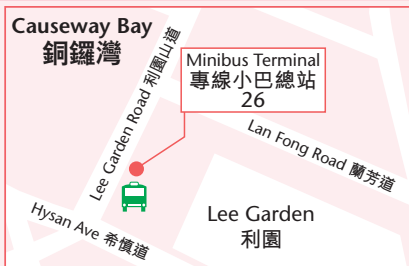

What is LEEP / Cone Biopsy? 甚麼是電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查？

Loop electrosurgical excision procedure (LEEP) and cone biopsy are medical procedures used to diagnose and treat abnormal cells on the cervix. These procedures involve removing a small amount of cervical tissue, which is then sent to the laboratory for analysis.

電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查是用於診斷和治療子宮頸異常細胞的婦科醫療程序。這些程序涉及切除少量子宮頸組織，然後將其送往化驗室進行分析。

When is LEEP / Cone Biopsy Needed? 哪些情況應考慮接受電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查？

LEEP / cone biopsy may be recommended if:

- A Pap smear or other test shows abnormal cells on the cervix; or
- There are symptoms such as abnormal vaginal bleeding or discharge

If you are experiencing any of these symptoms or conditions, talk to your doctor to see if LEEP / cone biopsy is right for you.

如果您有任何以下症狀或情況，請與您的醫生討論，看看電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查是否適合您：

- 如果子宮頸抹片檢查（又稱柏氏抹片檢查）或其他檢測顯示子宮頸異常細胞，或
- 異常的陰道出血或分泌物

How Should I Prepare for a LEEP / Cone Biopsy? 接受電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查前須知？

Before undergoing LEEP / cone biopsy, you will need to follow your doctor's instructions, which may include fasting for a period of time and stopping certain medications.

在進行電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查之前，您需要按照醫生的指示作準備。這可能包括禁食一段時間，及停止服用或使用某些藥物。

What can I Expect After a LEEP / Cone Biopsy? 接受電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查後注意事項？

After the procedure, you may experience some discomfort or cramping, as well as light bleeding or discharge. You should avoid sexual intercourse and using tampons for two weeks.

進行電環切除手術 / 錐形活組織檢查後，您可能會感到少許下腹不適，以及輕微出血或出現分泌物。您應在兩星期內避免使用衛生棉條，及避免行房。
